## 2017 FTTH Project

<u>Construction Update:</u> The General Manager reported that JCS and NCS have completed the outside network installation. Staff will be working on closing out these contracts for future Board approval.

<u>Electronics Update:</u> The General Manager reported that the Calix electronics have been installed and the contractors are working on finalizing the E7 and Brocade ring configurations.

<u>Cutover Process</u>: The General Manager reported on the specifics of the cutover process – including the maintenance associated with disconnecting the existing HFC system and cross-connecting to the inside wiring. Based upon this time consuming process, the Board concurred to hire contractors to assist with these maintenance activities.

<u>Transport Options:</u> The General Manager updated the Board on different transport route options and estimated costs associated with construction and equipment.

The General Manager gave the Board a tour of the NOC Building and new Fiber-to-the-Home equipment.
