2017 FTTH Project

<u>Construction Update:</u> The General Manager reported that all of the main line duct has been installed and that the remaining NCS crews will be finishing the installation of vaults, service drops and cleanup. The General Manager also reported that NCS's subcontractor – JCS has all six northbound fiber routes installed and terminated in the NOC Building and that their crews are currently pulling/splicing and field testing the associated spurs from these northbound routes.

<u>Electronics Update:</u> The General Manager reported that staff had met with Goldfield/Calix to review the bid details in efforts to finalize the order. Equipment delivery and installation is targeted for mid-August.

<u>Transport Options:</u> The General Manager updated the Board on different transport route options and estimated costs associated with construction and equipment. The General Manager will bring back transport route proposals for the Board's review and approval upon receiving firm pricing.
