We are very excited to announce that CRMU will begin construction on a state-of-the-art fiberto-the-home (FTTH) network beginning in the spring of next year! This project will connect every home and business to our Network Operations Center (NOC) with their own individual fiber.

CRMU has already awarded bids for the procurement of the major materials for this project (*i.e. duct, concrete handholes, fiber-optic cable, etc.*) and will most likely award the contract for the outside plant construction at CRMU's December Board Meeting.

In the following month, CRMU will be hosting technical sessions with fiber-optic electronics vendors after which we will prepare a detailed specification and bid packet for the fiber-optic electronics.

Voice and data transmission via fiber are more secure than conventional copper as it eliminates the ability to tap, or eavesdrop through contact with the network.

Once installed, fiber is more easily upgraded by changing the electronics that create the light pulses, and not replacing the cable itself.

Keep Your Meters Clear

Snow and ice can damage or block natural gas meters and exhaust vents for appliances, especially following a major winter storm.



Chimneys and vents on the roof or side of a building must be clear to allow proper venting, which prevents accumulation of carbon monoxide or equipment malfunction.

Carefully remove snow or debris using your hands or a broom. Kicking or using a shovel could cause damage. Safely remove icicles from overhead eaves and gutters so dripping water does not splash and freeze on the meter or vent pipe. If you need help, contact a professional.
