2017 FTTH Project

<u>Construction Update:</u> The General Manager reported that JCS and NCS have completed the outside network installation. Staff will be working on closing out the construction contract for future Board approval.

<u>Electronics Update:</u> The General Manager reported that the Calix electronics have been installed and the contractors are working on finalizing the E7 and Brocade ring configurations.

<u>Cutover Process:</u> The General Manager reported that prior to Monday, 35 or 6.3% of all services had been converted over to the new FTTH system. The General Manager also reported that the contractors A&J Connections began with cutovers on January 22nd with one crew of 2 people – and that a second 2-person crew will start on January 29th.

The Board and staff performed their annual detailed review of the following financial information: FY 2019 Budgets, Investment Policy, Depository Limitation Agreements, Electric & Gas Economic Reserve Funds, PILOT payments to the City of Coon Rapids and Equipment Replacement Schedules.
