Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation

The Iowa Department of Natural Resources (IDNR) has identified deficiencies in CRMU's ability to comply with our permit limits that must be addressed.

The main issue is that CRMU's collection system is receiving way too much inflow and infiltration (I&I) which overloads our lagoon treatment system not allowing it to effectively treat the waste stream within IDNR limits.

The I&I is mainly due to the deterioration of our infrastructure (i.e. pipe and manholes) due to age—as a lot of CRMU's collection system is comprised of vitrified clay pipe laid in 5-foot Substation Upgrades sections almost 100 years ago.

CRMU is in the process of developing a comprehensive pipe rehabilitation program to address the issue.

Electric Vehicles—EVs

Electric Vehicles or EVs are coming! CRMU is staying up-

to-date with the fast changing legislative and regulatory environment in Iowa that is being developed to accommodate EVs.

The Board of Trustees is also working very hard to address electric distribution system issues and to develop fair and equitable policies associated with charging station build-outs, transformer upgrades, service entrance upgrades, EV real-time rate structures, separate metering, etc.

Reliability CKIVIO Has Inc. CRMU has hired to develop the plans & specifications for the replacement of our east transformer at our main

substation located on the southwest corner of 7th Avenue and Park St

CRMU will be going out for bids on the transformer in the spring of 2020, with installation to follow in the spring of 2021.

New 69-kV Transmission Tie



In the spring of 2020, work should be completed on a 2nd 69-kV transmission tie for CRMU.

The tie will be operated in a "normally closed" position such that CRMU will receive power from a "looped" grid which will increase CRMU's reliability and resiliency.

The new tie line will extend from the 69-kV line that currently ends at the POET Ethanol plant to ITC's new Railway Switching Station being constructed southeast of Bayard on Hwy 25.



Keep Your Meters & Vents Clear

Snow and ice can damage or block natural gas meters and exhaust vents for appliances, especially following a major winter storm. Chimneys and vents on **the** roof or side of a building must be clear to allow proper venting, which prevents accumulation of carbon monoxide or equipment malfunction.

Carefully remove snow or debris using your hands or a broom. Kicking or using a shovel could cause damage. Safely remove icicles from overhead eaves and gutters so dripping water does not splash and freeze on the meter or vent pipe. If you need help, contact a professional.
